COVID-19: When to Self-Quarantine and When to Self-Isolate



If you are being tested for COVID-19, pease self-quarantine while you wait to receive the laboratory results from your healthcare provider.

What is self-isolation?

- Separate people infected with COVID-19 from people who are NOT infected
- People in self-isolation should avoid any activities outside their home except for getting necessary medical care



What is self-quarantine?

- Separate people who had close contact with a person with COVID-19 away from others without exposure
- Helps prevent spread of disease that can occur before a person knows they are infected with or without feeling any symptoms

When can I end self-isolation and leave my home?

Most persons with MILD or MODERATE COVID-19

- Discontinue isolation 10 days after symptoms have started AND
- No fever for at least 24 hours without use of medications AND
- Improved symptoms

Persons with SEVERE or CRITICAL COVID-19

- Extended isolation for up to 20 days after symptoms have started AND
- No fever for at least 24 hours without the use of medications AND
- Improved symptoms

Persons WITHOUT symptoms and tested positive

 Discontinue isolation after 10 days have passed from first positive test result date

When can I end self-quarantine and leave my home?

- Staying home for 14 days is recommended after your last contact with a person with COVID-19. This is the best way to prevent the spread of the disease.
- Quarantine can end after Day 10 WITHOUT testing AND WITHOUT any symptoms daily.
- Quarantine can end after Day 7 WITH a NEGATIVE test AND WITHOUT any symptoms daily.

What if I need to visit my doctor while I am waiting for my test results?

- ➤ Call your doctor first and tell them that you have been tested for COVID-19 and are waiting for results
- ➤ Wear a facemask when you go out
- ➤ Walk or take a private car. Do not ride public transportation or use ride-sharing.
