<b>Rhinoviruses</b> Many types of viruses can cause a cold, rhinoviruses are the most common virus. A cold virus enters your body through your mouth, eyes or nose, and can spread in the air when someone who is sick touch, coughs, sneezes or talks.	Causes	<b>Influenza</b> The flu is caused by influenza viruses. These viruses spread when people with flu touch, cough, sneeze or talk, sending droplets with the virus into the air.
