
Colorectal Cancer Screening Saves Lives Start getting screened at 50!

WHY IT MATTERS

- Colorectal Cancer Screening (CRC screening) can prevent cancer through the detection and removal of precancerous growths.
- CRC screening can detect cancer at an early stage, when treatment is usually more successful.
- Treatment for colorectal cancer in its earliest stage can lead to a 90% survival rate after five years.



SCREENING METHOD:

Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT)

Procedure to determine occult blood in stool for diagnose Colon cancer.

★HOW OFTEN: Once a year

Low cost

Performed at home Non invasive

No diet restrictions

DID YOU KNOW

If everyone **50** years or older had regular screening tests, at least **6 of 10** deaths from Colorectal cancer could be avoided each year.

HOW IS THE TEST DONE?



 Get a test packet from your doctor. Read ALL packet insert directions carefully before sample collection. 2. Follow the directions accordingly, collect a small sample of that stool and put it in a sample vial.







3. Return the sampling bottle to your doctor or lab in envelope provided within 48 hours.
